OLEAN AREA YOUTH COURT

The Olean Area Youth Court is a highly successful delinquency intervention/prevention program servicing first time offenders between the ages of 7 and 17 years old.

The Youth Court members are high school students from Olean, Allegany-Limestone, Portville and Hinsdale. Students are required to complete a structured training program and successfully pass a final law exam. They serve as the judge, side judge, facts attorney and law guardian.

Olean was founded in 1804 and has a long, exciting history. The story of Olean is beautifully presented at the Bartlett House and Olean Point Museum. Hear about the people who saw Olean's potential and settled along the river. Learn about the folklore, the businesses, the politicians, and the veterans. See the craftsmanship of the Queen Anne style home built in 1881 when Olean was the center of the oil industry.

The staff at the Bartlett Center has supplied numerous local organizations with materials to enhance their displays and activities. Tours are free of charge on Wednesdays and Fridays from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM. The center is also available to rent for private events including weddings, showers, and birthday parties.
