The Franchot Park event will give the park a facelift and will include raking, picking up litter, refurbishing the structures in the park and contracting Vincent Alejandro to paint a mural on the handball wall. Numerous residents and organizations, such as BonaResponds, have already offered their services.

The land for Franchot park was donated by Nicholas V.V. Franchot, Olean's first Mayor. In offering the land to the City, Mr. Franchot's son, Lt. Col. C. Paschal Franchot said, "The gift of his generosity, in which shall be heard for years to come the laughter of happy children, protected in their play; and which will provide as well a place of rest and relaxation for older people and another spot of beauty in the city he has loved."
