Sealed proposals for the construction of the Runway 4-22 Rehabilitation Contract will be received at the City of Olean Municipal Building, Department of Public Works, 101 East State Street, Olean, New York 14760 **until 11:00 am, local time, April 15, 2021**, and there, at said office, at said time, opened and read aloud.

**Due to current circumstances, the general public will not be able to attend the bid opening in person. Any interested person or organization who wish to witness the bid opening can do so through a web-based video/teleconference. The scope of this project is to mill the surface course off of the Runway and place a bituminous truing and levelling course followed by a nominal 2-inch overlay. It is anticipated to replace up to 10% of the pavement area with a full depth pavement section along with crack repairs. Also included will be pavement markings. No lighting will be included in this project.

The Contract Documents (consisting of the Advertisement, the Proposal, the Agreement, and the Specifications) and the Contract Drawings may be obtained only by download from a OneDrive site. After award, the low bidder shall be prepared to hold bid prices for anticipated start of construction expected in Spring of 2022, weather dependent. The execution of the construction Contract is dependent upon the receipt of an FAA grant offer and is expected no earlier than September 2021. This Contract does not allow for price escalation in unit bid items. The Contractor shall take this into consideration when preparing unit prices for bidding.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total maximum proposal price (combination of base bid or alternate bid plus add-on items) for the contract in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Preparation of Proposal.
