City of Olean to Extend Hours at the Front Street City Lot for Disposal of Storm Debris

September 8, 2020—Olean—William J. Aiello, Mayor of the City of Olean, has announced extended hours for the Front Street City Lot, near the intersection of Seneca Street, for residents to dispose of brush, tree branches and limbs that were downed during the wind storm on Monday, September 7, 2020. The lot will be opened:

Tuesday, September 8, 2020 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Wednesday September 9, 2020 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Saturday, September 12, 2020 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The lot will be opened for Olean residents only and identification with proof of residency will be required. The lot will be supervised by a City of Olean employee. Paper bags are allowed but no plastic please.

"I drove through the City following the storm and noticed significant damage in a number of neighborhoods. I am pleased to direct the Department of Public Works to extend the hours at the Front Street Facility to assist Olean residents after this latest wind storm," Mayor Aiello said.
