City of Olean Starts Pedestrian Action Plan

May 13, 2021—Olean—Mayor Aiello and the Department of Public Works are excited to announce that construction will commence for the Pedestrian Safety Action Plan Project this summer. The Olean Common Council awarded the project to Lake Shore Paving last night and the project consists of intersection improvements at four intersections around the City of Olean. Intersections and the planned improvements are shown below:

- Main and Center Street – New Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon
- Constitution Avenue and N 24th Street – Allegheny River Valley Trail Crossing – New Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon
- North Union Street at N 1st Street – Enhanced crossing with new curb ramps, curbing, crosswalk, and crossing signage
- Washington Street at Washington West – New enhanced crossing in front of the school with new curb ramps, crosswalk and school crossing signage

This project, funded 100% by New York State Department of Transportation, will continue to support our efforts toward safety improvements for pedestrians and cyclists around the City and promote a Walkable Olean, safe routes to schools and parks. Work is anticipated to start in June 2021.
