OLEAN, CATTARAUGUS COUNTY, NEW YORK

Sealed bids for the construction of a 280' L x 10'W x 4" D asphalt connector trail between 12th and 13th street in the City of Olean, Cattaraugus County, New York, will be accepted by the Olean Urban Renewal Agency (OURA) until 10:00 am, on May 20, 2022. Bids should be submitted to the OURA Office located at 101 East State, Olean, NY 14760. Bids will be opened by OURA staff immediately after they are due at 10:00 am on May 20, 2022.

Bids should be sealed and clearly marked "Sealed Bids for the Olean Urban Renewal Agency – Allegheny River Valley Trail 12th & 13th Street Connector".

Plans, specifications, and bid forms may be examined at the office of E & M Engineers and Surveyors, P.C., 24 Derrick Road, Bradford, PA 16701.

Copies of specifications and bid forms may be obtained from the office of E & M Engineers and Surveyors, P.C., for a non-refundable price of \$50.00 payable to the Olean Urban Renewal Agency. There will be a \$15 postage fee payable to E & M Engineers and Surveyors, P.C. for mailing bidding documents. Addenda, if any, will be issued only to those firms with name and address on record with the Engineer as having obtained the bidding documents.

A certified check or bank draft payable to the order of the Olean Urban Renewal Agency, or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the Bid shall be submitted with each bid. A performance bond and payment bond in the amount of 100 percent (100%) of the contract as awarded will be required as security for faithful performance of the contract.

The successful contractor will be required to comply with all applicable prevailing wage rates, and the contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, age, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms prescribed. The Owner reserves the right, as its interests may require, to reject any and all proposals or waive any formalities or technicalities.
